
A Take On Prosperity

remember the Sunday about five and a half years ago when this tall, fair-haired guy showed up at Unity and introduced himself as a compulsive songwriter who

was interested in offering his services to our church. I was naturally skeptical but nonetheless intrigued. These days a lot of people call themselves songwriters and the really good ones are not legion. He came again the following Sunday and persisted with his request to get together so he could play me a few of his songs and see what I thought. His name, of course, was Mark Shepard. Mark likens himself in these initial encounters to a little dog tugging at my pant leg. Not an entirely inappropriate analogy! He had only very recently discovered that Unity was quite surprisingly up his spiritual alley. He had just moved to town and immediately sought us out. He was excited to have found a spiritual home where he could offer his gifts.

I eventually made it over to his dwelling in Schenectady and was introduced to the work of one massively talented, highly creative and driven musician. He pulled out a couple of hefty 3-ring binders stuffed with a sampling of songs from his very prolific 30+ year output and began sifting through them for some choice tunes to play for me. I wasn't sure how many of the selections I heard would find an immediate fit in our church's musical repertoire, but they were never the less expertly played and cleverly crafted, revealing an ingenious mind and strong musical sensibilities. Within another week or so. Mark joined our music team and taught us his We Shall Live in Light, a simple and highly effective chant-perfect for Unity's message of the "Christ in all persons"—and it quickly became a regular, rousing way for us to close a service.

Mark's claim to a songwriting compulsion soon became evident as he began penning new songs especially for our church community. Often they were inspired by Rev. Jim Fuller's sermons, like the *I Live in God* with its anthemic chorus, or the tongue -in-cheek *My Dysfunctional Delusion*. Some of our visiting guest speakers also sparked new song ideas. Rev. Sonya Milton, for example, gave a talk based on a Rumi poem that resulted in the quite remarkable song *Break the Wine Glass*.

As I was off in the Pacific Northwest when you played your last couple of services at Unity, I want to take this opportunity to publicly thank you, Mark Shepard, for your incredible gifts to our community and to our music program over the past several years. It has been a total blast making music with you, Mark, nearly every Sunday for all that time – we're talking several hundred services! You always gave it everything you had and you brought amazing energy and creativity to our music. I wish you all the best as you attempt to bring that gift to the wider community of Unity, New Thought and the Posimusic movement. **Rock on, dude!**



Little Buddha and I would like to invite you to spend some time with us—Little Buddha is the wise young spirit girl who comes to share her wisdom in stories she shares with me.








Elaine playfully calls the evening gathering a "Kirtoncert" – it's part concert and part sacred chant kirtan service.

A key to serving others, with joy, is to discover those activities that exercise our unique gifts/talents along with those service opportunities that bring us joy and soul-nourishment rather than the spiritual depletion that can occur when serving only out of a sense of obligation. By attempting various service opportunities, Penny Palagyi was able to find a way to give of herself to the Unity Church community that brought her joy and spiritual fulfillment.

It is hard to believe that I have been attending Unity Church for almost eight years!

I came to Unity because I felt like I needed a quiet place to center, slow down, and take care of my spirit. I wasn't feeling a deep spiritual connection at the church I had been attending at the time. So, at the encouragement of my dear friend John Reith, I attended my first service. I have to admit that after that first service, I wasn't sure I would come back despite the fact that I loved the music and I knew Roger from being the director of music at my former church many years ago. I am a counselor and an educator and I always tell my clients that before they give up on something new, like coming to counseling, to come three times. So I made that same commitment to myself about attending Unity. By the fourth service, I was hooked.

After coming to Unity for a year, there was a request/need for adults to step forward and work with the children at Unity by providing spiritual lessons during the 11:00 service. I had watched June O'Toole leave with 8-10 children to teach the children's lesson every Sunday by herself and I was told she had been doing this service for a long time. As an educator by profession, I felt I "should" step up and help. I loved meeting June and working with her and the children. She had such a beautiful way of being with them. I continued to work with the children for two and a half years. However, I missed being at the service myself and remembered that I came to Unity to take care of my spirit and to slow down. At one point, Reverend Jim did a talk on service and shared that service should fill you with joy and bring joy to others. But I realized that I had been looking at service as something I "should" do, whether I liked it or not. I then remembered volunteering to decorate the fellowship hall for the Christmas Party. There were three of us and we laughed and enjoyed ourselves all afternoon.

The next thing I volunteered for was Circulation Day. In preparation for Circulation Day, we walked the area neighborhoods leaving notices on our church neighbors' doors inviting them to come and enjoy giving and receiving gently used items. My daughter and I got to meet many more of the beautiful people at Unity. We helped with Circulation Day for two years and it was a wonderful experience helping many of the people of our neighborhood. We also had a great time coming to the church for spring cleanup day and helping out.

During this time, I continued to work with the children's program. However, it began to feel more like a life-draining obligation than a life-giving opportunity of myself and my talent. I remembered Rev. Jim's words to give in a spirit of joy so I asked myself what gave me the most joy at Unity and the answer was easy....it was the music. I gathered my courage and asked Roger if I could sing with them. I began standing in the back on the platform (with the Mic off) and gained confidence from there. The joy I experienced at the rehearsals, the Sunday morning services, and the special friendships I made with such a talented group of musicians has been priceless. To serve in this manner was such a gift to me and brings me such joy. It truly allows me to give of my talent in the spirit of joy and I receive so much more than I give.

So find your place to give and serve and remember it is not about creating another obligation for yourself; It is about giving from a place of joy and finding that your gift is returned back manyfold.
