As I mentioned in my welcome, this morning I'll share passages of inspiration about love, and about our first four core values. After each, I'll offer a moment or two of silence, and a few gently guided reflection questions/statements that you can hold lightly in your heart-mind. If you do jot down any thoughts/insights that appear, you can keep it for your spiritual practice at home, or you can add it to the butterfly nets at our Love Offering if you want to share your insights with me, or have me hold you in prayer about a specific area.

Let's begin by coming into stillness, and centering together...

Gently close your eyes or simply let your gaze settle in front of you...

Sense your feet resting on the floor and notice all the places where your body is supported as you sit...

taking a deep breath in... and ...out...allow yourself to arrive gently and fully in the stillness and softening of this moment...

Listen to the voice of Spirit gently speaking to your heart and mind...

and set your intention for this inward journey trusting that as you go deeply inside, you affirm that you rest always in the ever-present love of God...

Breathing in, and out... bring your awareness now to your heart center...

sense the rhythm of your heart beating, and sense the physical space of your whole heart center...
